ROBIN FAMILY : Making wines from eight generations, our wines cover few Libourne appellation as Bordeaux, Bordeaux Supérieur, Lussac Saint-Emilion et Pomerol.

ROBIN HISTORY: For the Vins Robin Company, a successful vintage comes from a harmonious blend of soil, extraordinary weather conditions, and skilled winemaking. When these three elements come together, wine of the highest quality is the result. From the plant to wines selling, we realize every step. We have under control our distribution network and no wines are on supermarket.

HISTORY OF CHATEAU BUSQUET: Owner, winemaker from many generations, ROBIN family has bought this propriety in 1973 and enlarged it.



APPELLATION LUSSAC SAINT-EMILION A.O.C (Rouge)

LOCATION: This vineyard is made up on limestone soil around the château.

VINEYARD: 50% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon for this wine very well balanced with no excess tannins.

VILIFICATION: This vineyard is the special responsibility of Dominique Robin who believes that traditional methods should be married to modern technology to produce the best quality possible from each parcel of vines. Vinification in stainless steel vats lasts between 20 and 30 days according to the vintage, to produce fruity, aromatic wines. The wines are well-balanced; without excessive tannin, for drinking young. They also seem to age well.

Tasting NOTES: 50% Merlot, 40% Cabernet Franc, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon for this wine which is very well balanced with no excess tannins. Nice toasty oak aromas and flavors with blackberries showing through. Great with steak-decant one hour before serving.

Ideal with grilled red meats, veal, poultry, meat in sauce and cheeses and chocolate
